## **ORDINANCE NO. 2025-2 – FIRST PUBLICATION**

## CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Five

## AN ORDINANCE

That the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Cambridge be amended on a Zoning Petition by the City Council (Multifamily Housing Zoning Petition – Part Two) to amend the Cambridge Zoning Ordinance in Articles 1.000, 5.000, 11.000, 15.000, 17.000, 19.000, and 20.000 with the intent of: (1) revising open space standards to provide greater flexibility by allowing all types of open space to contribute to meeting requirements; (2) revising certain standards of the Affordable Housing Overlay so they are not more restrictive than comparable standards for residences in base zoning; (3) making project review special permit requirements applicable in all zoning districts and applicable to residential development of 75,000 square feet or more; (4) updating advisory development review procedures and introducing a new Planning Board Advisory Consultation for some larger development not subject to a special permit, similar to what is currently required in the Affordable Housing Overlay; (5) establishing a process for ongoing review and reporting on housing production throughout the city; and (6) revising other parts of the Zoning Ordinance for internal consistency.

Passed to a second reading at the City Council meeting held on January 27, 2025 and on February 10, 2025 the question comes on passage to be ordained.
