To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am writing to inform you that I am appointing Tracy Rose Tynes and requesting to reappoint Yoyo Yau to the Coordinating Council for Children, Youth and Families (also known as “Family Policy Council”) effective April 27, 2026.

Tracy is currently the Interim Public Health Officer. Previously, she was the CPHD Senior Director of Clinical Services and Nurse Manager for School Health Services.

Yoyo Yau will continue serving as a Specific Area Representative for a one-year term. Yoyo has been serving as the Chief Executive Officer for Bridges Homeward since 2023. She is a licensed mental health counselor and was a Chief Program Officer at the Boston Neighborhood Center for 13 years before coming to Bridges Homeward.
