I support designation of the Albert V. Scott House at 28 Union Street as a Cambridge Landmark. I concur with the Cambridge Historical Commission's designation report and recommendations for landmark designation because of its historical associations with Alberta V. Scott, the first Black graduate of Radcliffe College during her residence in the home, as well as for its important associations with the Woods and Payne families during the post-Civil War period. The architectural significance of the house as an example of residential construction during the early industrialization period of the neighborhood's development also justifies landmark designation.
