Subject: Gun Violence in Cambridge




Fellow Council Members,


Attachment A: Gun Violence Activity Map (live map)

Number of all confirmed shooting incidents in Cambridge, by category.


Date Range: 01/01/2015 - 06/07/2018




Number of all confirmed shooting incidents in Cambridge, by month.
