RESTROOMS ARE NOT AVAILABLE

Lace up your hiking shoes and get ready to walk into the past on the Cemetery Trail Hike. Learn about the history of the park and visit historic graves and other remnants of our past. Approximately 2.75 miles roundtrip on paved trails with some hills. Meet at the Area 1 Parking Lot; from the entrance station (3488 Main St., Brewster), drive into the park on Deer Park Road for a half mile. Look for the parking area on your right. 508-896-3491.
