




Racial/Ethnic Composition




Enrollment in Free and Reduced Lunch Program






Suspensions

- *In-District Suspensions* 60 students (3.6%) were suspended one or more times to this program.


• By Race/Ethnicity



• By Lunch, SPED and LEP

































7th Grade Algebra Exam

- In 2000/2001, 91% of students passed the 7th Grade Algebra Exam and in 1999/2000, 75% of students passed.




7th Grade Algebra Exam by School




No results were available for the Amigos, Morse, and Fletcher/Maynard Schools
